Blackstone gives back

Enstall Empowers began supporting Solar Energy International (SEI) when we noticed our shared commitment to building a more equitable and sustainable future through more accessible solar education and training. Enstall's racking companies, such as IronRidge and PanelClaw, have supported SEI over the years by donating equipment to SEI's lab yard, giving students the chance to work with industry-leading products.

Our partnership strengthened earlier this year when Enstall Empowers and SEI received \$75,000 for securing third place out of almost 400 other companies in Blackstone's Gives Back Challenge.

These funds were directed to support veterans through tuition assistance, setting the stage for the Solar Ready Veterans Program. This program helps veterans transition into solar industry careers by providing the skills and training they need to succeed. Together, Enstall Empowers and SEI will create a comprehensive curriculum to prepare workers for entrylevel solar jobs. SEI will also offer scholarships to veterans to further their education in solar energy, ensuring that cost won't stand in the way of pursuing a career in the field.

"We are honored to collaborate with Enstall to expand opportunities for both career seekers and veterans looking to get into the solar industry," said Chris Turek, Vice President of Marketing and Business Development at SEI. TRAINING WITH ROC VAN TWENTE



We partnered with ROC van Twente to deliver high-quality solar training, preparing students for success in the renewable energy sector. The ROC team recently attended a course at the Esdec Innovation Center, led by Mark van Stralen, where they learned about the latest advancements in installation materials and methods. This training enables instructors to equip students with cutting-edge skills for solar installation projects. Upon graduation, students can further their expertise with Esdec and earn an Esdec certification. Adding solar installation to the ROC curriculum marks an important step in advancing practical green energy education.

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT WITH ROAD2WORK



We were proud to support a solar project that not only generates clean energy but also helps cultivate a future solar workforce by supporting individuals overcoming employment barriers. Road2Work assists people with limited access to the job market in preparing for careers in the mainstream workforce. By connecting them with companies, sharing knowledge, and providing opportunities for growth, Road2Work creates a supportive environment and offers professional guidance. We successfully installed 288 solar panels on their roof using Enstall's Esdec racking materials, providing cost savings that will be reinvested into their programs.

THE COMMUNITY PROJECT: ETHIOPIA



In partnership with The Community Project: Ethiopia and Twende Solar, this solar project brought electricity and hope to the community of Debre Birhan, Ethiopia. The 8.64 kW system consisting of Enstall's IronRidge racking materials will provide energy independence, granting their community education and access to technology. The K-8 school, which is expected to serve 1,200 students when completed, will provide a platform for children and families to expand their knowledge, learn first-hand agricultural and energy conservation techniques, develop analytical thinking skills, and cultivate the ability to lead successful, contributing lives.

HAWAII'S OHANA FOOTPRINT PROJECT



We were honored to stand with the Ohana Footprint Project in rebuilding Hawaii after the devastating fires earlier this year. Through Project: Rebuild Hawaii & Workforce Development, 1,512 solar panels will be installed to restore sustainable energy access to affected communities. Additionally, this initiative will train local individuals in solar technologies, fostering long-term resilience. Our support includes a donation of IronRidge racking materials essential for these installations. By building back greener, we aim to support immediate recovery, pave the way for a sustainable future, and turn recovery into an opportunity for growth and innovation.

MAD SCIENCE'S SHINING WITH SOLAR



We partnered with Mad Science to create "Shining with Solar" workshops, designed to introduce elementary school students to the science of solar energy. Mad Science, renowned worldwide for their interactive STEM programs, is dedicated to inspiring young minds to explore science, technology, engineering, and math. With over 150 locations across 20 countries, their workshops are both educational and fun. The response to our initiative was impressive, with 25 schools signing up to bring solar education into their classrooms. We launched our first workshop at Esdec's Innovation Center where many colleagues and their children participated.

GRID'S SOLAR FUTURES PROGRAM



We supported GRID's Solar Futures Program which provides high school and middle school students in underserved schools and tribal communities with classroom and hands-on learning opportunities in clean energy technologies. By educating and equipping students, the goal of the Solar Futures Program is to open the door for the next generation of solar and renewable energy workers, advocates, and leaders. The program provides students with the opportunity to learn about the industry, build a resume, complete mock interviews, and graduate with job-ready skills to obtain an entry-level job if they choose to enter the workforce.

To continually raise the bar, we set ambitious goals for ourselves each year. In 2024, we aimed to train 4,000 new installers. However, due to a market slowdown and decreased demand, we fell short of this target, training 3,097 new installers. Despite this, we exceeded our goal for panel installations, achieving an impressive 3,869 panels—far surpassing our target of 750—thanks to two major projects.


In collaboration with Footprint, we contributed to rebuilding efforts in Hawaii. Unfortunately, much work remains unfinished, and in 2024, Hurricane Helene caused significant damage in North Carolina, adding to the challenges we face. 


